Financial Report – Andy Peterson

- Dues are beginning to be received.

- Seal coating is a major expense, but infrequent
- Irrigation maintenance costs are higher this year, and may stay higher for a number of years until all valves are eventually replaced.

Roads/Signs Report – Lynda Corliss

- Seal Coating Complete
- Most neighbors complied with the restrictions to ensure that the coating was successful.
- Requesting 5-year plan from Pavement Maintenance.

Picnic Update – Lynda Corliss

- Rain & thunder was a scare, but did not impact the event
- Ice cream truck was cost-effective and very popular
- About 60 adults & 13 kids

Landscaping Report – Debbie Taylor

- Back 40 Cleanup & irrigation update
 - Still have an area near Lots 42-43 to be trimmed down.
 - All sprinklers working in the area.
- If homeowners gather leaves, etc. from the common areas for removal, please place them in small piles near the street or in your green composting bin. Removal of branches and larger debris is not included in our current maintenance plan.
- Tree maintenance request from Lot 26

- Large HOA tree is sick and leaning toward a non-WW house; Estimate \$300/yr for 3 years to treat the tree.
- Board approves treatment cost.
- Tree maintenance request from Lot 16
 - Tree is dead and needs to be removed. Straddles property line. Estimate removal cost of \$3000, to be split with homeowner.
- Two small fruit trees on HOA property near Lots 16 & 17 are also dead.
 Estimate \$500 to remove both trees if done at the same time as the Lot 16 tree. Board approves removing the three trees.
- Tree planning for 2023 & beyond
 - Older trees are dying. We may need to budget for taking them down in the future.
 - Getting an arborist to create a maintenance plan would be \$1600-\$5000.
